“GROSS SALES-PROFESSIONAL FEES AND/OR CHARGES” – (PART OF SEC. 1. OF LICENSE CODE)

Gross Sales, Professional Fees and/or Charges – Where the amount of a license is based upon gross sales, professional fees and/or charges, the terms “gross sales, professional fees and/or charges,” unless the contrary clearly appears, shall mean all sales, professional fees and/or charges, whether for cash, on time or for credit, and shall not contemplate any deductions for any purpose not specifically provided for, and shall mean all sales, professional fees and/or charges, regardless of the place where the sale, professional fee and/or charge was solicited or place where the contract of sale, professional fees and/or charges was consummated, or the place of delivery.

“PRECEDING YEAR” – (PART OF SECTION 1. OF LICENSE CODE)

The term “preceding year” shall mean the next year preceding the current tax year.

“FALSE OATH TO PROCURE LICENSE” – (SECTION 22. OF LICENSE CODE)

False Oath to Procure License – That it shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly and willfully make any false written affidavit, certificate or statement as to the amount of stock on hand, or volume of gross sales, professional fees and/or charges, receipts, revenues or business or amount of capital invested in business, or number of employees or vehicles used, and to file such affidavit with the City Clerk or any license collector or inspector, or any deputy license inspector or collector for the purpose of defrauding the City of Gardendale by procuring license for a less sum than is lawfully due by the affiant or his principal.

“PENALTY FOR DOING BUSINESS WITHOUT A LICENSE” – (SECTION 25. OF LICENSE CODE)

Penalty for Doing Business Without A License – Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished within the limits of and as provided by Chapter 14, Title 12 of the Code of Alabama, 1975.
