

**GARDENDALE, ALABAMA  
CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
JUNE 21, 2010**

The City Council of the City of Gardendale, Alabama, met in a regular meeting on the 21st day of June, 2010, at 6:00 p.m., at the Gardendale City Hall. Mayor pro tem Gary Morris, presiding in the absence of Mayor Othell Phillips, called the meeting to order. Councilor Currington led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Othell Phillips was not present.

City Clerk Keith Mosley was present and served as clerk.

MINUTES

The council was presented with a copy of the minutes of the regular council meeting held on June 7, 2010. Councilor Currington made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilor Tumlin and carried by unanimous consent of the council members in attendance.

VISITORS

State representative Allen Treadaway presented two grant fund checks from the State of Alabama to Mayor pro tem Morris: one in the amount of \$2,500 for picnic tables at the splash pad pavilion and picnic tables and two bench swings at the Miracle League field, and one in the amount of \$500 for the Gardendale Historical Commission. He stated that a \$5,000 grant has also been approved for the library, and those funds will be presented to the City in the near future.

Ms. Tonya Brown spoke about her experience as a two-time breast cancer survivor. She then invited everyone to attend, sponsor, or participate in the "Pink Ribbon Run" 1-mile fun run and 5K walk at the soccer complex on Friday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>. She said the net proceeds from this event will raise funds for the "Susan G. Komen 3-Day for the Cure" cancer fundraiser.

Mr. Joe Knight, candidate for Jefferson County Commission District 4; Mr. Ronnie Dixon, candidate for Jefferson County Commission District 4; and Mr. Bobby Humphries, candidate for re-election to Jefferson County Commission District 3 spoke about their experience and qualifications for the offices they are seeking and requested support for their candidacy in their run-off elections on July 13.

Parks & Recreation assistant superintendent Dale Hyché, attending for Parks & Recreation superintendent Stan Hogeland who was not present, reported the following: (a) The youth softball program at Luman Harris Park has ended for this season; (b) The youth baseball program at Noble Park will conclude tonight; (c) The Park & Rec department is preparing for the upcoming youth football season; (d) The splash pad and the pavilions at the splash pad are extremely popular. He said the pavilions are rented nearly continuously every day during the entire time that the area is open to the public.
