

**GARDENDALE, ALABAMA
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
JULY 19, 2010**

The City Council of the City of Gardendale, Alabama, met in a regular meeting on the 19th day of July, 2010, at 6:00 p.m., at the Gardendale City Hall. Mayor Othell Phillips called the meeting to order. Boy Scout Garrett Wood led the Pledge of Allegiance. Harold McClendon from Central Baptist Church delivered the devotional and led the prayer.

City Clerk Keith Mosley was present and served as clerk.

MINUTES

The council was presented with a copy of the minutes of the regular council meetings held on July 7, 2010. Councilor Harper made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilor Phillips and carried by unanimous consent of the council members.

VISITORS

Gardendale High School rising senior Martin Bear received a proclamation from Mayor Phillips in recognition of his participation in the 2010 Alabama Boys State program, his school activities and accomplishments, and his volunteering at the Gardendale-Martha Moore Public Library and the Gardendale Arts Council. BILLS

Councilor Currington made a motion to approve payment of the July 19 bill list, as listed on "Exhibit A," which is attached hereto and made a part of these minutes. The motion was seconded by Councilor Harper and carried by unanimous consent of the councilors.

COUNCILORS' REPORTS

Councilor Morris reported that the Arts Council sponsored a musical performance this past Saturday, July 17, at the Civic Center by the groups "Back In Time" and "Rock Candy." He said the event was a great success with a standing-room-only crowd of more than 350 people attending.

DEPARTMENT HEADS' REPORTS

Police Chief Mike Walker reported the following: (a) He made reference to the June report of police activities that he had given to the mayor and council members previously. (b) He announced that the Police department has a new Facebook account and Twitter account to inform the public of police-related matters.

Library director Connie Smith - No report.

Fire Chief Clint Doss - No report.

Parks & Recreation superintendent Stan Hogeland reported the following: (a) The "Pink Ribbon Run," a fundraiser for the Susan G. Komen cancer research and awareness fundraiser, will be held this Friday evening, July 23, at the soccer fields. He said 135 people have signed up to participate, and more are expected to register at the event. (b) The department is conducting a day camp this week. (c) The Ultimate Frisbee program will continue on Thursday nights through August 5. (d) The summer sports programs are winding down for this year, and the fall sports programs are preparing to begin soon. (e) Work at Memorial Park will resume this week as a result of receiving funds from Jefferson County Commission president Bettye Fine Collins. Also, Richard Bradley installed about fifty additional engraved bricks at Memorial Park last week.

Civic Center director John Brigham - No report.

Public Works assistant director Mike Wallace, attending for Public Works director Jeff Holliyan who was not present, reported the following: (a) All of the the Public Works department's mowers are in operating condition and are in use eight hours a day. (b) The department is assisting the Police department on the Cluster Springs property with the setup of the new firing range. (c) Fleet Maintenance serviced 133 City vehicles during June.

City Clerk Keith Mosley - No report.

Inspection Services superintendent Robert Ryant was not present.

OLD BUSINESS

APPLICATIONS FROM WALGREEN CO. FOR APPROVAL OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSES. Mayor Phillips stated this item was carried over from the previous council meeting on July 7 but would be tabled again until the next council meeting on August 2 at the request of the Walgreens store manager who had a scheduling conflict and was not able to attend this meeting.

Councilor Tumlin then made a motion to have these properties mowed and for the cost of the mowing to be assessed as a lien against the property. The motion was seconded by Councilor Currington. There was no discussion. The motion carried by unanimous consent of the councilors.

APPLICATIONS FROM FRIENDLY PETROLEUM, LLC, FOR APPROVAL OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSES. Mr. Ahmed Abassi, representative of Friendly Petroleum, LLC, d/b/a Gardendale Raceway, located at 606 Fieldstown Road, appeared before the council for approval to transfer an existing "Retail Beer: Off-Premises Only" alcoholic beverage license and an existing "Retail Table Wine: Off-Premises Only" alcoholic beverage license. Mayor Phillips stated that the Police, Inspections, and Administrative departments have conducted their reviews of the applications and have no objections to the approval of the applications. There were no questions from the council members. There was not a motion to approve the applications, but when Mayor Phillips called for a vote the applications were approved by a 4-1 vote of the council members, with Councilors Tumlin, Morris, Currington, and Harper voting aye and Councilor Phillips voting nay.




